1. **Fees** \*Scholarship info is available through the SSYSA office  
**Option 1 (\$200) – WSSL League Play and Tournament Play**  
**Option 2 (\$125) - Tournament Play**
2. **Player photo 1”X 1” size** (showing face from neck up please!) for their 08/09 CYS Player Pass Card.
3. **Birth Certificate (copy)** must be supplied for all NEW competitive players.
4. **Commitment Contract** completed and signed by player AND parent
5. **Medical Release form** must be completed for all new and returning players
6. **Uniform order form/payment**  
For those players/teams needing to order new uniforms, the individual order form must be turned in with other completed paperwork also by 01/26/09, with check made out to “SSYSA”. \*Check will not be deposited until uniforms are delivered in early August.
7. **Work Deposit check for \$200 per player, \*\*\*NEW THIS YEAR**  
**\*DUE to SSYSA by 3/15/09 (or can be included with player registration by 01/26/09)**  
**This check needs to be post-dated 7/31/09, and made out to “SSYSA”**  
The Steamboat Mountain Soccer Tournament income goes toward reducing fees for competitive players. Currently each player is subsidized with more than a \$200 fee reduction for competitive soccer. This year we are incorporating a Work Deposit of \$200 per athlete, with a two athlete per family max of \$400 to encourage volunteerism (\*does not apply to graduating high school seniors). **All work deposits are due and will be held and not deposited until the required 4 hour/athlete shift (or 8 hour max) is completed during the 2009 Steamboat Mountain Tournament** (or other possible work options through SSYSA if unable to work during the tournament). Checks will be shredded on completion of your shift.
